Business Meeting

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – The minutes from the July 28th, 2020 CLC Council meeting were presented, and consensus was reached as submitted.

Ministry Discussions and updates

- Stewardship On track for launch on 9/21. Theme is "Expanding the Possibilities".
- Communications Discussions about finding a better solution for the weekly email blasts (constant contact / mail chimp). Cheryl asked for thoughts on a more efficient and professional way to keep in touch.
- Education / Family Ministries Wednesday nights will be for Families with kids in programming. No solution yet for what to do with members who do not have kids in programming. We need to keep the population down.....do we consider another night for families and individuals without kids in programming? Surveys are due back this week from the families who have children in programming.
- Anchor Church Woyatan "Indian Center" will possibly need more than the
 original \$60k projected to finish the facility. Cheryl made an inquiry to Black Hills
 Community foundation as well as Thrivent for matching funds. Tutoring assistance is
 also needed at this center.

- Calvary in Action Karla is still making meals for Meals on Wheels and WAVI. They are very please with everything that Karla has done for them this summer.
- Hospitality / Volunteerism Tom is asking the Kin Ministry members to help making congregational calls. Council is to contact LeeAnn for a list of names to contact.
