Transportation

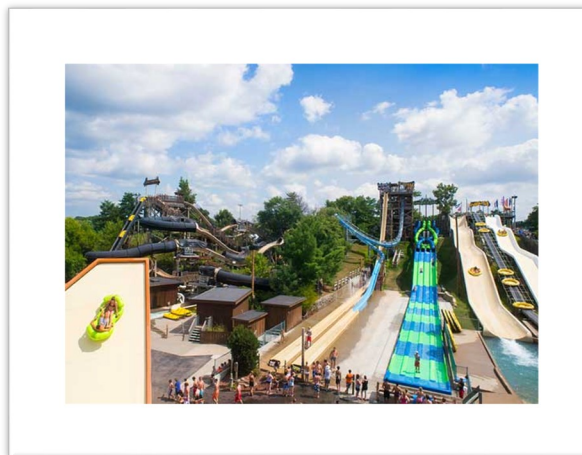
We will travel to Kenosha on a charter bus from Calvary Lutheran Church.
