Purpose for mentoring:

- Provide support and guidance
- Create a presence
- Advocate for youth,
- Unconditionally love, serve, and be the people of God to our youth.

Roles of a Mentor

Mentors provide a consistent and supportive relationship with a youth by:

- Giving unconditional love
- Being a good listener
- Recognizing adults do not have all the answers
- Praying and encouraging
- Caring supporter of youth and family
- Being an adult connection to the church
- Helping youth with statement and developing positive self-image
- Challenging youth to live a Christ-like life
- Helping youth reflect and learn from experience
- Helping youth learn about and take responsibility
- Getting to know youth parents
- Once a month visit in a safe environment
- Phone call every couple of weeks
- Adult and student sign covenant
- Attend school event

Who Are Mentors?

Mentors are trusted adult volunteers who are caring, empathetic and want to make a positive difference in a child's life. Mentors are consistent role models who develop a supportive relationship with our middle school youth.

What Is Mentoring?

Mentoring is a caring adult volunteer walking side by side with a young person, helping them to become all that God intended them to be.

Mentoring is the privilege to help a young person navigate his/her faith journey as he/she takes on the surroundings of the world.

Why Mentor?

Research has shown that young people benefit from close, caring relationships with safe adults who serve as positive role models.

Scripture encourages us to:

“Tend the flock of God that is in your charge, exercising the oversight, not under compulsion but willingly, as God would have you do it-- not for sordid gain but eagerly” (1Peter 5:2).
