FEEDING BODIES AND SOULS: ALL-YEAR WEDNESDAY MEAL AND WORSHIP


Since making the bold move from our
Cottonwood property, our church has
developed a vibrant Wednesday night program.
Feeding 300-400 each Wednesday is more than just a
meal and worship for young families. It is also our largest meal
for seniors, an age-group that needs fellowship opportunities as well
as a healthy meal. The Wednesday meal is where fellowship happens between
generations of people.

This year, we want to take another bold step by making the Wednesday night meal and worship year-round. Those who join us want to go to church, and Wednesday fits their needs. We currently offer this meal and worship 26 times a year; and for some, that is the only time we see them. People are hungry to hear the Word of God and to have time to connect. "Picture the Possibilities" of what this bold move can do to enhance the picture of our faith family.

Many people work tirelessly, giving of their time and energy for the meal and worship. An expansion of helpers and praise band musicians will be needed to accomplish year-round Wednesday programs. It will cost about \$20,000 to make this happen. Let's "Picture the Possibilities."
