



Your gifts are invisible on the 1099-R form. It only shows the total withdrawal amount, with no mention of any tax-free transfers to charity. The QCD must be reported on your tax return to avoid payment of taxes. Be sure to keep an acknowledgment from the charity, showing that it received your contribution in your tax records.
